Daily Weather Forecast Distribution On Saturday 5 July 2025

Time Issued 2300 LST

General Situation

The low-pressure cell covers upper Laos with the moderate southwest monsoon prevails over the Andaman Sea, Thailand and the Gulf. Isolated heavy rain is likely in Thailand. People in the upper country and the South (west coast) should beware of heavy rain and accumulation that may cause flash floods and overflows, especially along the waterways near foothills and lowlands.

The moderate wind and waves in the upper Andaman Sea are expected about 2 meters high and above 2 meters high in thundershowers. In the lower Andaman Sea and the upper Gulf, the waves are expected 1-2 meters high and above 2 meters high in thundershowers. All ships in the Andaman Sea and the Gulf should proceed with caution and keep off thundershowers.

In addition, tropical storm "DANAS", expected to move near Taiwan during 6-7 July 2025. This storm is forecast to not move to Thailand with no direct effect on Thailand's weather but induced the strengthening southwest monsoon prevails over Thailand.
