<p>Weather Forecast: During 4 – 6 Jul and 9 – 10 Jul, the moderate to rather strong monsoon trough will lie across the upper North, the upper Northeast and Laos into the low-pressure cell over upper Vietnam while the moderate southwest monsoon prevails over the Andaman Sea, Thailand and the Gulf. Isolated heavy rains are likely in the country while isolated very heavy rains are possible in the North, the Northeast and the East regions.</p> <p>During 7 – 8 Jul, the monsoon trough will move lie the upper Myanmar and the upper Laos while the moderate southwest monsoon still prevails over the Andaman Sea, Thailand and the Gulf. Isolated heavy rains are likely in the country.</p> <p>The moderate wind and waves in the upper Andaman Sea are expected about 2 meters high and above 2 meters high in thundershowers. In the lower Andaman Sea and the upper Gulf, the waves are expected 1-2 meters high and above 2 meters high in thundershowers.</p> <p>In addition, tropical depression over the South China Sea is expected to intensify to tropical storm and move pass Taiwan during 7 - 9 July 2025. This storm is forecast to not move to Thailand.</p>			
<p>Warning: people in Thailand especially in the North, the Northeast and the East should beware of heavy to very heavy rains and accumulation that may cause flash floods and overflows, especially along the waterways near foothills and lowlands.</p> <p>All ships in the Andaman Sea and the Gulf should proceed with caution and keep off thundershowers throughout the period.</p>			
<p>The weather forecast is valid from Friday this week until Thursday next week</p>			
<p style="text-align: center;">North</p>	<p>Scattered to fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rain throughout the period. Isolated very heavy rains mostly in the upper part during 4 – 6 Jul and 9 – 10 Jul. Southwesterly winds 10 – 20 km/hr. Minimum temperature 22 – 25 °C. Maximum temperature 29 – 34 °C.</p>		
<p style="text-align: center;">North eastern</p>	<p>Scattered to fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rain throughout the period. Isolated very heavy rains mostly in the upper part during 4 – 6 Jul and 9 – 10 Jul. Southwesterly winds 10 – 20 km/hr. Minimum temperature 22 – 26 °C. Maximum temperature 28 – 34 °C.</p>		
<p style="text-align: center;">Central</p>	<p>Scattered to fairly widespread thundershowers throughout the period and isolated heavy rains. Southwesterly winds 10 – 20 km/hr. Minimum temperature 23 – 26 °C. Maximum temperature 32 – 34 °C.</p>		
<p style="text-align: center;">Eastern</p>	<p>Scattered to fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rains. Isolated very heavy rains during 4 – 6 Jul and 9 – 10 Jul. Southwesterly winds 15 - 35 km/hr. Wave height 1-2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers. Minimum temperature 23 – 26 °C. Maximum temperature 29 – 33 °C.</p>		
<p style="text-align: center;">Southern (East Coast)</p>	<p>During 4 – 5 Jul, scattered thundershowers. During 6 – 10 Jul, scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rains. Southwesterly winds 15 - 30 km/hr. Wave height about 1 meter and above 2 meters in thundershowers. Minimum temperature 23 – 26 °C. Maximum temperature 30 – 34 °C.</p>		
<p style="text-align: center;">Southern (West Coast)</p>	<p>During 4 – 5 Jul, scattered thundershowers. During 6 – 10 Jul, scattered to fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rains. From Phang Nga upward: southwesterly winds 20 – 35 km/hr. Wave height about 2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers. From Phuket downward: southwesterly winds 15 – 35 km/hr. Wave height 1 - 2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers. Minimum temperature 23 – 26 °C. Maximum temperature 28 – 33 °C.</p>		
<p style="text-align: center;">Bangkok Metropolitan Region</p>	<p>Scattered to fairly widespread thundershowers throughout the period and isolated heavy rains. Southwesterly winds 10 – 20 km/hr. Minimum temperature 25 – 27 °C. Maximum temperature 31 – 34 °C.</p>		
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
