<p>Weather Forecast: During 26 - 29 Jul, the low-pressure cell covers upper Vietnam and the Gulf of Tonkin while the rather strong southwest monsoon prevailing over the Andaman Sea, Thailand and the Gulf will weaken. Isolated heavy rains are likely in Thailand and isolated very heavy rains are possible in the upper North and the Northeast regions. The rather strong wind and wave in the Andaman Sea and the Gulf will weaken. The waves in the upper Andaman Sea and the upper Gulf are expected about 2 meter high and above 2 meters high in thundershowers. In the lower Andaman Sea, the wave are expected 1 - 2 meters high and above 2 meters high in thundershowers.</p> <p>During 30 - 31 Jul, the southwest monsoon prevailing over the Andaman Sea, Thailand and the Gulf will weaken while the low pressure cell covers upper Vietnam. Less rains are likely in the country and isolated heavy rains are possible in the upper Northeast and the East regions. The moderate wind and wave in the upper Andaman Sea are expected about 2 meters high and above 2 meters high in thundershowers. In the lower Andaman Sea and the upper Gulf, the wave are expected 1 - 2 meters high and above 2 meters high in thundershowers.</p> <p>In addition, severe tropical storm “CO-MAY” over northwestern of Philippines is moving northeastward. It is expected to move through upper Philippines into the Pacific Ocean by today (25 Jul). This storm is not move to Thailand. The travelers should check the weather forecast for the region you're going to be visiting.</p>			
<p>Warning: During 26 - 28 Jul, people in Thailand especially in the upper North and the Northeast should beware of heavy to very heavy rains and accumulation that may cause flash floods and overflows, especially along the waterways near foothills and lowlands. All ships in the Andaman Sea and the Gulf should proceed with caution and keep off thundershowers, small boat in the upper Andaman Sea and the upper Gulf keep ashore lasting 25 Jul.</p>

Wave height about 2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers. During 30 – 31 Jul, southwesterly winds 15 - 35 km/hr. Wave height 1 - 2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers. Minimum temperature 23 – 29 °C. Maximum temperature 29 – 35 °C.</p>

Wave height about 1 meter, 1 - 2 meters offshore and above 2 meters in thundershowers. During 30 – 31 Jul, southwesterly winds 15 – 35 km/hr.
