

	Weather Forecast Division Thai Meteorological Department	Medium Range Forecasts Weather Outlook During 1 - 7 Nov 2025	
Weather Forecast: During 1 – 2 Nov, The monsoon trough will move up to lie across the upper South, the East, the Central and the lower Northeast into the active low pressure cell over the South China Sea. Meanwhile, the weak high-pressure system covering upper North and the upper Northeast with the southeasterly wind prevail over the North and the Central. Isolated heavy rains are forecast in the upper country and the upper South. During 3 – 7 Nov, less rain is likely in the upper Thailand due to the monsoon through will move down to lie across the lower Central, the East and the upper South. Meanwhile, the high-pressure system is still covering upper North and the upper Northeast ,causing cool monings in these area . Isolated heavy rains are forecast in the South. The moderate wind and waves in the upper Gulf and upper Andaman Sea are expected 1 - 2 meters high. In the lower Gulf and the lower Andaman Sea, the waves are expected about 1 meter high and above 2 meters high in thundershowers throughout the period.			
Warning: People in upper Thailand should keep healthy due to changeable weather and farmers should prevent for crop damage. All ships in the Gulf and the Andaman Sea should proceed with caution and keep off thundershowers throughout the period. During 1 – 2 Nov, people in the upper country and the upper South should beware of heavy rains and accumulation that may cause flash floods and overflows especially along the waterways near foothills and lowlands.			
The weather forecast is valid from Saturday this week until Friday next week			
North	During 1 – 2 Nov, scattered to fairly widespread and isolated heavy rains. During 3 – 7 Nov, Morning cool. Isolated to scattered thundershowers. Minimum temperature 19 – 26 °C. Maximum temperature 30 – 34 °C. Cool to cold on the mountain top. Minimum temperature 8 - 17 °C. Easterly winds 10 – 15 km/hr.		
North eastern	During 1 – 2 Nov, scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rains During 3 – 7 Nov, Morning cool. Isolated thundershowers. Minimum temperature 21 – 25 °C. Maximum temperature 28 – 33 °C. Cool to cold on the mountain top. Minimum temperature 14 - 19 °C. Easterly winds 10 – 20 km/hr.		
Central	During 1 – 2 Nov, scattered to fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rains. During 3 – 7 Nov, scattered thundershowers. Variable winds 10 – 20 km/hr. Minimum temperature 22 – 25 °C. Maximum temperature 30 – 34 °C.		
Eastern	During 1 – 2 Nov, scattered to fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rains. During 3 – 7 Nov, scattered thundershowers. Variable winds 15 – 35 km/hr. Wave height about 1 meter and 1 - 2 meters offshore and above 2 meters in thundershowers. Minimum temperature 23 – 26 °C. Maximum temperature 28 – 33 °C.		
Southern (East Coast)	Scattered thundershowers throughout the period and isolated heavy rains in the upper part during 1 - 2 Nov. From Chumphon Upward: Variable winds 15–35 km/hr. Wave height 1-2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers. From Surat Thani Downward: westerly winds 15–30 km/hr. Wave height about 1 meter and above 2 meters in thundershowers. Minimum temperature 22 – 25 °C. Maximum temperature 30 – 33 °C.		
Southern (West Coast)	Scattered thundershowers throughout the period and isolated heavy rains during 1 – 2 Nov. Phuket upward: southwesterly winds 15 – 35 km/hr. Wave height 1 - 2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers. Krabi downward: westerly wind 15 – 30 km/hr. Wave height about 1 meter and above 2 meters in thundershowers. Minimum temperature 23 – 25 °C. Maximum temperature 29 – 33 °C.		
Bangkok Metropolitan Region	During 1 – 2 Nov, scattered to fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rains. During 3 – 7 Nov, scattered thundershowers. Variable winds 10 – 20 km/hr. Minimum temperature 25 – 27 °C. Maximum temperature 31 – 33 °C.		
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
