

	Weather Forecast Division Thai Meteorological Department	Medium Range Forecasts Weather Outlook During 23 - 29 Nov 2025	
Weather Forecast: During 23 – 25 Nov, the strong high-pressure system covering upper Thailand, the upper South and the South China Sea is weakening with an increase in temperature and morning fog in upper country. Morning cool to cold are forecast in North and the Northeast. The Northeast are 2 - 4 °C increase in temperature while cool in the morning and 1 - 3 °C increase in temperature are possible in the rest regions except for the lower South. During 26 – 29 Nov, another moderate to rather strong high-pressure system from China will extend to upper Thailand and the South China Sea with cool to cold, a decrease in temperature and strong winds. A decrease in temperature by 4 – 7 °C is forecast in the Northeast, 3 – 5 °C is forecast in the Central including Bangkok and its vicinity and the East while and 2 – 4 °C is forecast in the upper South. For the South, the low-pressure cell covers the lower Andaman Sea and Malaysia while the rather strong northeast monsoon prevails over the upper Gulf, the upper South and the Andaman Sea with isolated heavy to very heavy rains in the lower South during 23 – 25 Nov. The rather strong wind force the waves in the Gulf and the Andaman Sea offshore up to be 2 - 3 meters high and above 3 meters high in thundershowers. During 26 – 29 Nov, the low-pressure cell over the lower Andaman Sea and Malaysia will move into the Sumatra and the lower Bay of Bengal while the moderate northeast monsoon will prevail over the upper Gulf and the upper South. In addition, an active low-pressure cell over the Pacific Ocean will intensify, is expected to move to the lower Philippines and the middle South China Sea during 24 - 25 Nov. After that, this storm is forecast to move near the coast of lower Vietnam during 28 – 29 Nov while the high-pressure system cover Vietnam and the South China Sea. This storm will decline rapidly and not move to Thailand but leading to the northeasterly wind prevailing over upper Thailand will strengthening.			
Warning: During 23 – 25 Nov, people in the lower South beware of heavy to very heavy rains and accumulation that may cause flash floods and overflows especially along the waterways near foothills and lowlands. All ships in the Gulf and the Andaman Sea should proceed with caution and keep off thundershowers throughout the period, small boats in the Gulf and the upper Andaman Sea offshore keep ashore lasting 25 Nov.			
During 26 - 29 Nov, people in the upper country and the upper South should keep healthy due to cool to cold weather and beware of fire due to dry air and strong wind.			
The weather forecast is valid from Sunday this week until Saturday next week			
North	During 23 – 25 Nov, morning cool with fog and 1 – 3 °C rise in temperature. Minimum temperature 15 – 23 °C. Maximum temperature 27 – 33 °C. Cold to very cold on the mountain top. Minimum temperature 6 - 15 °C. Northeasterly winds 10 – 15 km/hr. During 26 – 29 Nov, cool to cold and 3 – 5 °C drop in temperature with strong wind. Minimum temperature 12 – 20 °C. Maximum temperature 24 – 29 °C. Cold to very cold on the mountain top. Minimum temperature 3 - 12 °C. Northeasterly winds 10 – 25 km/hr.		
North eastern	During 23 – 25 Nov, morning cool to cold with light fog and 2 – 4 °C rise in temperature. Minimum temperature 15 – 23 °C. Maximum temperature 29 – 32 °C. Cool to cold on the mountain top. Minimum temperature 10 - 18 °C. Northeasterly winds 10 – 25 km/hr. During 26 - 29 Nov, cool to cold and 4 – 7 °C drop in temperature with strong wind. Minimum temperature 11 – 19 °C. Maximum temperature 24 – 29 °C. Cold to very cold on the mountain top. Minimum temperature 6 - 15 °C. Northeasterly winds 15 – 35 km/hr.		
Central	During 23 – 25 Nov, morning cool with light fog and 1 – 3 °C rise in temperature. Minimum temperature 19 – 24 °C. Maximum temperature 30 – 33 °C. Northeasterly winds 10 – 20 km/hr. During 26 – 29 Nov, cool and 3 – 5 °C drop in temperature with strong wind. Minimum temperature 17 – 21 °C. Maximum temperature 27 – 30 °C. Northeasterly winds 10 – 30 km/hr.		
Eastern	During 23 – 25 Nov, morning cool with light fog and 1 – 3 °C rise in temperature. Minimum temperature 21 – 26 °C. Maximum temperature 30 – 33 °C. Northeasterly winds 20 – 40 km/hr. Wave height 1 - 2 meters and 2 - 3 meters offshore. During 26 – 29 Nov, morning cool and 3 – 5 °C drop in temperature with strong wind. Minimum temperature 18 – 22 °C. Maximum temperature 27 – 30 °C. Northeasterly winds 15 – 35 km/hr. Wave height 1 - 2 meters and about 2 meters offshore.		
Southern (East Coast)	During 23 – 25 Nov, upper part: morning cool and 1 – 3 °C rise in temperature. Lower part: scattered to fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy to very heavy rains. During 26 – 29 Nov, upper part: morning cool and 2 – 4 °C rise in temperature. Lower part: isolated thundershowers. Northeasterly winds 20 – 35 km/hr. Wave height about 2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers. Minimum temperature 18 – 26 °C. Maximum temperature 25 – 33 °C.		
Southern (West Coast)	During 23 – 25 Nov, scattered to fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rains. From Krabi upwards: northeasterly winds 20 - 40 km/hr. Wave height about 2 meters, 2 – 3 meters offshore and above 3 meters in thundershowers. From Trang downwards: northeasterly winds 15 – 35 km/hr. Wave height 1 – 2 meters, above 2 meters in thundershowers and offshore. During 26 – 29 Nov, isolated thundershowers. From Krabi upwards: Northeasterly winds 20 - 35 km/hr. Wave height 1 - 2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers and offshore. From Trang downwards: Northeasterly winds 15 – 35 km/hr. Wave height about 1 meter and above 1 meter in thundershowers and offshore. Minimum temperature 22 – 26 °C. Maximum temperature 26 – 32 °C.		
Bangkok Metropolitan Region	During 23 – 25 Nov, morning light fog and 1 – 3 °C rise in temperature. Minimum temperature 22 – 26 °C. Maximum temperature 30 – 33 °C. Northeasterly winds 10 – 20 km/hr. During 26 – 29 Nov, morning cool and 3 – 5 °C drop in temperature with strong wind. Minimum temperature 18 – 22 °C. Maximum temperature 27 – 30 °C. Northeasterly winds 10 – 30 km/hr.		
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
