## Daily Weather Forecast Distribution On Wednesday 28 May 2025 Time Issued 2300 LST

## **General Situation**

The monsoon through lies across the North and the Northeast while the moderate southwest monsoon prevails over the Andaman Sea, the South and the Gulf with isolated heavy in the upper country and isolated very heavy rains are likely in the North. People in the country should beware of heavy to very heavy rains and accumulation that may cause flash floods and overflows, especially along the waterways near foothills and lowlands. Farmers should prepare by improving drainage systems in their agricultural areas to mitigate the potential impacts and damage to crops and livestock.

The rather strong wind forces the waves in the upper Andaman Sea up to about 2 meters high while 1-2 meters high in the lower Andaman Sea and above 2 meters high in thundershowers. All ships in the Andaman Sea and the Gulf should proceed with caution and keep off thundershowers. Small boats in the upper Andaman Sea should keep ashore.

In addition, during 28 – 30 May, the active low pressure cell over the upper Bay of Bengal will intensify and move near the coast of Bangladesh and India with no direct effect to Thailand.
