Daily Weather Forecast Distribution
On Thursday 29 May 2025
Time Issued 0500 LST

General Situation

The monsoon through lies across the North and the Northeast while the moderate southwest monsoon prevails over the Andaman Sea, the South and the Gulf with isolated heavy in the upper country and isolated very heavy rains are likely in the North and the Northeast. People in the country should beware of heavy to very heavy rains and accumulation that may cause flash floods and overflows, especially along the waterways near foothills and lowlands. Farmers should prepare by improving drainage systems in their agricultural areas to mitigate the potential impacts and damage to crops and livestock.

The rather strong wind forces the waves in the upper Andaman Sea up to about 2 meters high while 1-2 meters high in the lower Andaman Sea and above 2 meters high in thundershowers. All ships in the Andaman Sea and the Gulf should proceed with caution and keep off thundershowers. Small boats in the upper Andaman Sea should keep ashore.

In addition, during 29 – 30 May, the active low pressure cell over the upper Bay of Bengal will intensify and move near the coast of Bangladesh and India with no direct effect to Thailand.

Weather Forecast for Thailand from 6.00 a.m. Thursday to 6.00 a.m. Friday

<u>North</u>	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy to very heavy rains in Mae Hong Son, Chiang Mai, Chiang Rai, Lamphun, Lampang, Phrae, Sukhothai, Tak, Phitsanulok, and Phetchabun. Minimum temperature 24-26 °C. Maximum temperature 32-34 °C. Southwesterly winds 5-15 km./hr.
<u>Northeast</u>	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy to very heavy rains in Nong Khai, Bueng Kan, Sakon Nakhon, Nakhon Phanom, Kalasin, Mukdahan, Roi Et, Yasothon, Amnat Charoen, Nakhon Ratchasima, Surin, Sisaket, and Ubon Ratchathani. Minimum temperature 23-27 °C. Maximum temperature 32-34 °C. Southeasterly winds 10-20 km./hr.
<u>Central</u>	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rains in Kanchanaburi, Ratchaburi, Lopburi and Saraburi. Minimum temperature 25-27 °C. Maximum temperature 34-35 °C. Southwesterly winds 10-20 km./hr.
<u>East</u>	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rains in Nakhon Nayok, Prachin Buri, Sa Kaeo, Chachoengsao, Chonburi, Rayong, Chanthaburi and Trat. Minimum temperature 25-27 °C. Maximum temperature 32-35 °C. Southwesterly winds 15-30 km./hr. Wave height about 1 meter and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
<u>South, east coast</u>	Scattered thundershowers mostly in Phetchaburi, Prachuap Khiri Khan, Chumphon and Surat Thani. Minimum temperature 24-26 °C. Maximum temperature 33-36 °C. Southwesterly winds 15-30 km./hr. Wave height about 1 meter and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
<u>South, west coast</u>	Scattered thundershowers mostly in Ranong and Phang Nga. Minimum temperature 24-26 °C. Maximum temperature 32-34 °C. Phangnga upwards: Southwesterly winds 20-35 km./hr. Wave height about 2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers. Phuket downwards: Southwesterly winds 15-35 km./hr. Wave height 1-2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
<u>Bangkok and vicinity</u>	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rains. Minimum temperature 26-28 °C. Maximum temperature 33-35 °C. Southwesterly winds 10-20 km./hr.
