Daily Weather Forecast Distribution
On Saturday 5 July 2025
Time Issued 1700 LST

General Situation

The low-pressure cell covers upper Vietnam with the moderate southwest monsoon prevails over the Andaman Sea, Thailand and the Gulf. Isolated heavy rain is likely in Thailand and isolated very heavy rain possible in the East regions. People in the upper country and the South (west coast) should beware of heavy to very heavy rain and accumulation that may cause flash floods and overflows, especially along the waterways near foothills and lowlands.

The moderate wind and waves in the upper Andaman Sea are expected about 2 meters high and above 2 meters high in thundershowers. In the lower Andaman Sea and the upper Gulf, the waves are expected 1-2 meters high and above 2 meters high in thundershowers. All ships in the Andaman Sea and the Gulf should proceed with caution and keep off thundershowers.

In addition, tropical storm “DANAS”, expected to move near Taiwan during 7-9 July 2025. This storm is forecast to not move to Thailand with no direct effect on Thailand’s weather but induced the strengthening southwest monsoon prevails over Thailand.

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| <u>North</u> | Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Mae Hong Son, Chiang Mai, Chiang Rai, Lampang, Phayao, Nan, Phrae, Uttaradit and Tak. Minimum temperature 23-26 °C Maximum temperature 31-34 °C Southwesterly winds 10–20 km/hr. |
| <u>Northeast</u> | Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Loei, Nong Khai, Bueng Kan, Nong Bua Lamphu, Udon Thani, Sakon Nakhon, Nakhon Phanom, Mukdahan, Roi Et, Yasothon, Amnat Charoen, Sisaket and Ubon Ratchathani. Minimum temperature 23-26 °C Maximum temperature 31-34 °C Southwesterly winds 10–20 km/hr. |
| <u>Central</u> | Scattered thundershowers mostly in Nakhon Sawan, Uthai Thani, Chainat, Kanchanaburi and Ratchaburi. Minimum temperature 24-27 °C Maximum temperature 33-35 °C Southwesterly winds 10–20 km/hr. |
| <u>East</u> | Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy to very heavy rain in Nakhon Nayok, Prachin Buri, Rayong, Chanthaburi and Trat. Minimum temperature 25-28 °C Maximum temperature 32-34 °C Southwesterly winds 15–35 km/hr. Wave height 1-2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers |
| <u>South, east coast</u> | Scattered thundershowers mostly in Phetchaburi, Prachuap Khiri Khan, Chumphon, and Surat Thani. Minimum temperature 23-25 °C Maximum temperature 33-35 °C Southwesterly winds 15–35 km/hr. Wave height about 1 meter, 1-2 meters offshore and above 2 meters in thundershowers |
| <u>South, west coast</u> | Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rains in Ranong and Phang Nga. Minimum temperature 24-27 °C Maximum temperature 30-34 °C From Phang Nga northward : Southwesterly winds 20-35 km/hr. Wave height about 2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers From Phuket southward : Southwesterly winds 15-35 km/hr. Wave height 1-2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers |
| <u>Bangkok and vicinity</u> | Fairly widespread thundershowers. Minimum temperature 26-27 °C Maximum temperature 33-35°C Southwesterly winds 10-20 km/hr. |
