Daily Weather Forecast Distribution On Friday 25 July 2025 Time Issued 1700 LST

General Situation

The rather strong southwest monsoon prevails across the Andaman Sea, Thailand and the Gulf while the low-pressure cell over upper Vietnam with isolated heavy rain are possible in the North and the Northeast. People in these areas should beware of heavy rain and accumulation that may cause flash floods and overflows, especially along waterways near foothills and lowlands.

The rather strong wind forces the waves in the upper Andaman Sea and the upper Gulf up to 2-3 meters high and above 3 meters high in thundershowers. The wind and wave in the lower Andaman Sea are likely about 2 meters high and above 2 meters high in thundershowers. All ships in the Andaman Sea and the Gulf should proceed with caution and keep off thundershowers. Small boats in the upper Andaman Sea and the upper Gulf should keep ashore.

In addition, tropical storm "Co-may" over the northern part of the Philippines is expected to move to the south of Japan. This storm will not move to Thailand.
