Daily Weather Forecast Distribution On Friday 15 August 2025 Time Issued 1700 LST

General Situation

The monsoon trough lies across the North and the Northeast while the southwest monsoon prevailing over the Andaman Sea, Thailand and the Gulf is strengthening. At the same time, the low-pressure cell covers the lower North. More rains and isolated heavy rains are likely in the country while isolated very heavy rains are possible in the East and the South(west coast) regions. People in thease areas should beware of heavy to very heavy rains and accumulation that may cause flash flood and overflows, especially along the waterways near foothills and lowlands.

The rather strong wind force the waves in the upper Andaman Sea up to 2-3 meters high and above 3 meters high in thundershowers. In the lower Andaman Sea and the upper Gulf, the waves are likely about 2 meters high and above 2 meters high in thundershowers. All ships in the Andaman Sea and the Gulf should proceed with caution and keep off thundershowers, small boats in the upper Andaman Sea should keep ashore lasting 17 Aug.
