Daily Weather Forecast Distribution Thursday 18 September 2025 Issued at 2300 LST

General Situation

The monsoon trough lies across the Central, the East and the lower Northeast into the active low-pressure cell over the South China Sea while the moderate southwest monsoon prevailing over the Andaman Sea, the South and the Gulf will strengthen. Isolated heavy rain are likely in the country while isolated very heavy rain are possible in Bangkok and vicinity including the East. People in these areas should beware of heavy to very heavy rain and its accumulation that may cause flash flood and overflows, especially along foothills near waterways and lowlands.

The wind and waves in the upper Andaman Sea and the upper Gulf are likely about 2 meters high, the lower Andaman Sea, the waves are likely 1-2 meters high and above 2 meters high in thundershowers. All ships should proceed with caution and keep off thundershowers.

In addition, tropical storm "MITAG" over the upper South China Sea is expected to make landfall over South of China during 19–20 Sep with not approaching Thailand. The travelers should check the weather forecast for the region you're going to be visiting.

Weather Forecast for Thailand from Thursday midnight to Friday midnight	
North	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Tak, Sukhothai, Uttaradit, Phitsanulok and Phetchabun. Minimum temperature 23–25 °C. Maximum temperature 32–34 °C. Variable winds 5–15 km/hr.
Northeast	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Loei, Nong Khai, Bueng Kan, Sakon Nakhon, Nakhon Phanom, Mukdahan, Yasothon, Amnat Charoen, Nakhon Ratchasima, Buriram, Surin, Sisaket, and Ubon Ratchathani. Minimum temperature 23–25 °C. Maximum temperature 32–34 °C. Variable winds 10–15 km/hr.
Central	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Uthai Thani, Phra Nakhon Si Ayutthaya, Saraburi, Kanchanaburi, Suphan Buri, Ratchaburi, Samut Songkhram, Samut Sakhon and Nakhon Pathom. Minimum temperature 23–25 °C. Maximum temperature 32–34 °C. Variable wind 10–15 km/hr.
East	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy to very heavy rain in Nakhon Nayok, Prachin Buri, Sa Kaeo, Chachoengsao, Chon Buri, Rayong, Chanthaburi and Trat. Minimum temperature 23–25 °C. Maximum temperature 31–34 °C. Southwesterly winds 20–35 km/hr. Wave height about 2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
South, east coast	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Phetchaburi, Prachuap Khiri Khan, Chumphon and Surat Thani. Minimum temperature 23–25 °C. Maximum temperature 30–33 °C. Southwesterly winds 15–35 km/hr. Wave height about 1 meter, 1–2 meters offshore and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
South, west coast	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Ranong, Phangnga, Phuket and Krabi. Minimum temperature 23–26 °C. Maximum temperature 28–33 °C. From Phangnga northwards: Southwesterly winds 20–35 km/hr. Wave height about 2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers. From Phuket southwards: Southwesterly winds 15–35 km/hr. Wave height 1–2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
Bangkok and vicinity	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy to very heavy rain. Minimum temperature 24–25 °C. Maximum temperature 32–34 °C. Southwesterly winds 10–15 km/hr.
On Thursday	: Maximum temperature at 12.05 p.m. 33.9 ℃
On Friday	 : Maximum temperature 34 °C Minimum temperature 24 °C : Sunrise at 6.07 a.m. Sunset at 6.16 p.m. : High water at 7.10 p.m. and at - p.m. : Low water at 11.16 a.m. and at - p.m.
