Daily Weather Forecast Distribution Saturday 22 November 2025 Issued at 1700 LST

General Situation

The low-pressure cell covers the lower Andaman Sea and Malaysia while the rather strong northeast monsoon prevails over the upper Gulf, the upper South and the upper Andaman Sea with scattered heavy rains and isolated very heavy rains in the lower South. The rather strong wind force the waves in the Gulf and the Andaman Sea offshore up to be 2-3 meters high and above 3 meters high in thundershowers. All ships should proceed with caution and keep off thundershowers, small boats in the Gulf and the upper Andaman Sea offshore should keep ashore lasting 23 Nov.

The strong high-pressure system from China still covers upper Thailand, the upper South and the South China Sea. Cool to cold weather are forecast in the North and the Northeast while cool in the morning are possible in the Central including Bangkok and its vicinity, the East and the upper South regions. People in the upper country should keep healthy due to cool to cold weather and beware of fire due to dry air.
