Daily Weather Forecast Distribution

Thursday 14 May 2026

Issued at 2300 LST

**General Situation**

The southwesterly wind prevailing over the Andaman Sea and the South is strengthening with more rain and isolated heavy rain in the upper country especially in the western portion. People should beware of severe conditions, heavy rains and accumulation that may cause flash floods and overflows especially along the waterways near foothills and lowlands. Farmers should prevent for crop damage and animals danger.

The moderate wind and wave in the upper Andaman Sea are likely about 2 meters high and above 2 meters high in thundershower. All ships should proceed with caution and keep off thundershowers.

**Weather Forecast for Thailand from Thursday midnight to Friday midnight**

<b>North</b>	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Mae Hong Son, Chiang Mai, Chiang Rai, Lampang, Nan, Phayao, Uttaradit, Phitsanulok, Phetchabun, Tak and Kamphaeng Phet. Minimum temperature 21–26 °C. Maximum temperature 32–35 °C. Southwesterly winds 10–15 km./hr.
<b>Northeast</b>	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Loei, Nong Khai, Bueng Kan, Nong Bua Lamphu, Udon Thani, Nakhon Phanom, Chaiyaphum and Nakhon Ratchasima. Minimum temperature 23–26 °C. Maximum temperature 33–36 °C. Southwesterly winds 10–20 km./hr.
<b>Central</b>	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Uthai Thani, Kanchanaburi, Ratchaburi and Nakhon Pathom. Minimum temperature 24–26 °C. Maximum temperature 35–36 °C. Southwesterly winds 10–20 km./hr.
<b>East</b>	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Nakhon Nayok, Prachinburi, Chonburi, Rayong, Chanthaburi and Trat. Minimum temperature 23–25 °C. Maximum temperature 33–35 °C. Southwesterly winds 15–35 km./hr. Wave height 1-2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
<b>South, east coast</b>	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Chumphon, Surat Thani, Nakhon Si Thammarat, Songkhla, Phatthalung, Pattani, Yala and Narathiwat. Minimum temperature 23–25 °C. Maximum temperature 33–35 °C. Southwesterly winds 15–30 km./hr. Wave height about 1 meter and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
<b>South, west coast</b>	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Ranong, Phang Nga, Phuket, Krabi, Trang and Satun. Minimum temperature 23–25 °C. Maximum temperature 32–34 °C. Phangnga upwards: Southwesterly winds 20–35 km./hr. Wave height about 2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers. Phuket downwards: Southwesterly winds 15–30 km./hr. Wave height about 1 meter and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
<b>Bangkok and vicinity</b>	Scattered thundershowers. Minimum temperature 25–27 °C. Maximum temperature 34–36 °C. Southwesterly winds 10–20 km./hr.
