Daily Weather Forecast Distribution

Friday 15 May 2026

Issued at 1700 LST

**General Situation**

The southwest monsoon prevails over the Andaman Sea and the South with more rain and isolated heavy rain in the upper country, while isolated very heavy rain is likely in the North, the Central, and the East. People should beware of severe conditions, heavy rain and accumulation may cause flash floods and overflows, especially along waterways near foothills and lowlands. Farmers should take precautions against crop damage and danger to animals.

The strengthening wind forces waves in the upper Andaman Sea from Phang Nga northward to be 2–3 meters high and above 3 meters high in thundershowers. In the lower Andaman Sea and the upper Gulf, the waves are expected to be 1–2 meters high and above 2 meters high in thundershowers. All ships should proceed with caution and avoid thundershowers; small boats in the upper Andaman Sea should stay ashore.

**Weather Forecast for Thailand from 6.00 p.m. Friday to 6.00 p.m. Saturday**

<b>North</b>	Fairly widespread thundershowers and scattered heavy rain. Isolated very heavy rain in Mae Hong Son, Chiang Mai, Chiang Rai, Lamphun, Lampang, Tak, and Kamphaeng Phet. Minimum temperature 22–26 °C. Maximum temperature 29–34 °C. Southwesterly winds 10–20 km./hr.
<b>Northeast</b>	Scattered thundershowers and scattered heavy rain in Loei, Sakon Nakhon, Nakhon Phanom, Chaiyaphum, Kalasin, Mukdahan, Yasothon, Amnat Charoen, and Ubon Ratchathani. Minimum temperature 24–27 °C. Maximum temperature 35–37 °C. Southwesterly winds 10–20 km./hr.
<b>Central</b>	Scattered thundershowers and heavy rain. Isolated very heavy rain in Nakhon Sawan, Uthai Thani, Kanchanaburi, Nakhon Pathom, and Ratchaburi. Minimum temperature 24–27 °C. Maximum temperature 35–36 °C. Southwesterly winds 10–20 km./hr.
<b>East</b>	Scattered thundershowers and heavy rain. Isolated very heavy rain in Chanthaburi and Trat Minimum temperature 25–27 °C. Maximum temperature 32–35 °C. Southwesterly winds 15–35 km./hr. Wave height 1–2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
<b>South, east coast</b>	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Prachuap Khiri Khan, Chumphon, Surat Thani, Nakhon Si Thammarat, Songkhla, Pattani, Yala, and Narathiwat. Minimum temperature 23–26 °C. Maximum temperature 33–35 °C. Southwesterly winds 15–30 km./hr. Wave height about 1 meter and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
<b>South, west coast</b>	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Ranong, Phang Nga, Trang, and Satun Minimum temperature 23–26 °C. Maximum temperature 32–34 °C. Phangnga upwards: Southwesterly winds 20–40 km./hr. Wave height 2–3 meters and above 3 meters in thundershowers. Phuket downwards: Southwesterly winds 15–35 km./hr. Wave height 1–2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
<b>Bangkok and vicinity</b>	Scattered thundershowers. Minimum temperature 25–27 °C. Maximum temperature 34–36 °C. Southwesterly winds 10–20 km./hr.
