Daily Weather Forecast Distribution

On Friday 15 August 2025

Time Issued 2300 LST

General Situation

The monsoon trough lies across the North and the Northeast while the southwest monsoon prevailing over the Andaman Sea, Thailand and the Gulf is strengthening. At the same time, the low-pressure cell covers the lower North. More rains and isolated heavy rains are likely in the country while isolated very heavy rains are possible in the East and the South(west coast) regions. People in these areas should beware of heavy to very heavy rains and accumulation that may cause flash flood and overflows, especially along the waterways near foothills and lowlands.

The rather strong wind force the waves in the upper Andaman Sea up to 2-3 meters high and above 3 meters high in thundershowers. In the lower Andaman Sea and the upper Gulf, the waves are likely about 2 meters high and above 2 meters high in thundershowers. All ships in the Andaman Sea and the Gulf should proceed with caution and keep off thundershowers, small boats in the upper Andaman Sea should keep ashore lasting 17 Aug.

Weather Forecast for Thailand from Friday midnight to Saturday midnight

North	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rains in Chiang Mai, Chiang Rai, Lamphun, Lampang, Phayao, Nan, Phrae, Uttaradit, Phitsanulok, Pichit and Phetchabun. Minimum temperature 22-25 °C Maximum temperature 30-33 °C Variable winds 10-15 km/hr.
Northeast	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rains in Loei, Nong Khai, Bueng Kan, Nong Bang Lamphu, Udon Thani, Sakon Nakhon, Chaiyaphum, Khon Kaen and Nakhon Ratchasima. Minimum temperature 22-24 °C Maximum temperature 30-32 °C Southwesterly winds 10-20 km/hr.
Central	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rains in Suphanburi, Kanchanaburi, Ratchaburi, Nakhon Pathom, Samut Songkhram and Samut Sakhon. Minimum temperature 22-25 °C Maximum temperature 31-34 °C Southwesterly winds 10-20 km/hr.
East	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy to very heavy rains in Nakhon Nayok, Prachinburi, Sa Kaeo, Chachoengsao, Chonburi, Rayong, Chanthaburi and Trat. Minimum temperature 23-26 °C Maximum temperature 28-32 °C Southwesterly winds 20-35 km/hr. Wave height about 2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
South, east coast	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rains in Phetchaburi, Prachuap Khiri Khan, Chumphon, Surat Thani and Nakhon Si Thammarat. Minimum temperature 22-25 °C Maximum temperature 30-33 °C Surat Thani upward : Southwesterly winds 20-35 km/hr. Wave height 1-2 meters, about 2 meters offshore and above 2 meters in thundershowers. Surat Thani downward : Southwesterly winds 15-35 km/hr. Wave height 1 meter, 1-2 meters offshore and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
South, west coast	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy to very heavy rains in Ranong, Phang Nga, Phuket, Krabi, Trang and Satun. Minimum temperature 23-25 °C Maximum temperature 28-31 °C Phuket upward : Southwesterly winds 20-40 km/hr. Wave height 2-3 meters and above 3 meters in thundershowers. Krabi downward : Southwesterly winds 20-35 km/hr. Wave height about 2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
Bangkok and vicinity	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rains. Minimum temperature 25-27 °C Maximum temperature 31-33 °C Southwesterly winds 10-20 km/hr.
