Daily Weather Forecast Distribution Sunday 23 November 2025 Issued at 1100 LST

General Situation

The low-pressure cell covers the lower Andaman Sea and Malaysia while the rather strong northeast monsoon prevails over the upper Gulf, the upper South and the upper Andaman Sea with scattered heavy to isolated very heavy rains in the lower South. The rather strong wind force the waves in the Gulf and the Andaman Sea offshore up to be 2-3 meters high and above 3 meters high in thundershowers. All ships should proceed with caution and keep off thundershowers, small boats in the Gulf and the upper Andaman Sea offshore should keep ashore lasting 23 Nov.

The strong high-pressure system from China covering upper Thailand, the upper South and the South China Sea is weakening with an increase in temperature and morning fog. Cool to cold weather are forecast in the North and the Northeast while cool in the morning are possible in the Central, the East and the upper South regions. People in the upper country should keep healthy due to changeable weather and beware of fire due to dry air. All transports take more caution in poor visibility.

East	Morning cool with light fog and 1-2 °C rise in temperature.
	Minimum temperature: 20-24 °C Maximum temperature: 31-33 °C
	Northeasterly winds 20–40 km/hr.
	Wave height 1-2 meters and 2-3 meters offshore.
South, east coast	Upper part: Morning cool and 1-2 °C rise in temperature.
	Lower part: Fairly widespread thundershowers and scattered heavy to isolated very heavy rains in
	Nakhon Si Thammarat, Phatthalung, Songkhla, Pattani, Yala and Narathiwat.
	Minimum temperature: 21–24 °C Maximum temperature: 25-31 °C
	Northeasterly winds 20-40 km/ hr.
	Wave height 2-3 meters and above 3 meters in thundershowers.
South, west coast	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy to very heavy rains in Phuket, Krabi, Trang and Satun.
	Minimum temperature: 23–24 °C Maximum temperature: 26-30 °C.
	Phuket upwards: Northeasterly winds 20-40 km/ hr.
	Wave height about 2 meters, 2-3 meters offshore and above 3 meters in thundershowers.
	Krabi downwards: Northeasterly winds 20-35 km/hr.
	Wave height 1-2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers and offshore.
Bangkok and vicinity	Morning light fog and 1-2 °C rise in temperature.
	Minimum temperature: 22-24 °C Maximum temperature: 30-32 °C
	Northeasterly winds 10–20 km/hr.
