Daily Weather Forecast Distribution Saturday 1 November 2025 Issued at 1100 LST

General Situation

The active monsoon through remains across the upper South and the upper Gulf into an active low pressure cell over the middle South China Sea with the easterly wind and the southeasterly wind bring humid air to the North and the Central. Meanwhile the weak high-pressure system covers upper Thailand. Rain/thundershowers and isolated heavy rain are likely across the upper country and the South, while morning cool are possible in the North. Farmers should take precautions against crop damage. People in upper Thailand and the upper South should keep healthy due to changeable weather and be aware of heavy rain and its accumulation.

The moderate winds and waves in the upper Gulf and the upper Andaman Sea are expected to 1-2 meters high, and above 2 meters in thundershowers. In the lower Gulf and the lower Andaman Sea, waves are expected to be about 1 meter high, and above 2 meters in thundershowers.

Weather Forecast for Thailand from Saturday noon to Sunday noon	
North	Morning cool. Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Mae Hong Son, Chiang Mai, Tak, Kamphaeng Phet, Phitsanulok, Phichit, and Phetchabun. Minimum temperature: 22–24 °C Maximum temperature: 31–32 °C Cold on the mountain tops: Minimum temperature 8–17°C. Southeasterly winds: 10–15 km/hr.
Northeast	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Loei, Chaiyaphum, Khon Kaen, Nakhon Ratchasima, and Buri Ram. Minimum temperature: 22–24 °C Maximum temperature: 31–33 °C Cool to cold on the mountain tops: Minimum temperature 15–19°C. Easterly winds: 10–25 km/hr.
Central	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Nakhon Sawan, Uthai Thani, Chainat, Suphan Buri, Sing Buri, Ang Thong, Phra Nakhon Si Ayutthaya, Lop Buri, Saraburi, Kanchanaburi, Ratchaburi, Nakhon Pathom, Samut Sakhon, and Samut Songkhram. Minimum temperature: 23–24 °C Maximum temperature: 30–32 °C Southeasterly winds: 10–20 km/hr.
East	Fairly widespread rain/thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Nakhon Nayok, Prachin Buri, Chachoengsao, Sa Kaeo, Chon Buri, Rayong, Chanthaburi, and Trat. Minimum temperature: 24–26 °C Maximum temperature: 30–32 °C Southeasterly winds: 15–35 km/h. Wave height about 1 meter, 1-2 meters offshore and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
South, east coast	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Phetchaburi, Prachuap Khiri Khan, Chumphon, Songkhla, Yala, and Narathiwat. Minimum temperature: 23–25 °C Maximum temperature: 31–33 °C. From Chumphon Upward: Variable winds 15–35 km/hr. Wave height 1-2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers. From Surat Thani Downward: Variable winds 15–30 km/hr. Wave height about 1 meter and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
South, west coast	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Ranong, Phang Nga, Phuket, Krabi, Trang, and Satun. Minimum temperature: 23–25 °C Maximum temperature: 31–33 °C. From Phang Nga Upward: Westerly winds 15–35 km/hr. Wave height 1-2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers. From Phuket Downward: Southwesterly winds 15–30 km/hr. Wave height about 1 meter and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
Bangkok and vicinity	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rain. Minimum temperature: 25–26 °C Maximum temperature: 31–32 °C. Southeasterly winds: 10–20 km/h.
